Page no.	Errata
68	First paragraph of 'Step 2: Prepare Your Pattern Paper' should read: <i>You need a piece of pattern paper that's at least 10cm (4in) wider and longer than the section of garment you plan to clone. In my example this was 35cm (14in) wide by 55cm (22in) long for both the cami front and back.</i>
84	Second bullet point in 'Garment Analysis' section should read: <i>The front edge of the shirt is a mock button stand, an edge that has been folded to the right side of the garment and topstitched in place. There are eight 1cm (3/8in) buttons and buttonholes which is 1.5cm (5/8in) wide.</i>
