- 4 grams, Turmeric (A), #24251
1 gram, Custard (B), #24558
17 grams, Silver (C), #24586
(WeCrochet Palette Fingering)
- 1 gram, White (D), #26082
(WeCrochet Stroll Fingering)
- US No. 7 Steel crochet hook (1.5 mm)
- Fiberfill
- Black and white felt
- Black embroidery thread

Finished size approximately
5 in tall x 3 in wide
(13cm x 8cm)

With yarn A

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] around (54)

RNDS 10–12: 54 sc (54)

RND 13: [7 sc, sc2tog] around (48)

RNDS 14–15: 48 sc (48)

RND 16: [6 sc, sc2tog] around (42)

RNDS 17–18: 42 sc (42)

RND 19: [5 sc, sc2tog] around (36)

RNDS 20–21: 36 sc (36)

RND 22: [Sc2tog, 1 sc] around (24)

RND 23: 24 sc (24)

RND 24: [6 sc, sc2tog] around (21)

RND 25: 21 sc (21)

Stuff and continue stuffing.

RND 26: [5 sc, sc2tog] around (18)

RND 27: 18 sc (18)

RND 28: [4 sc, sc2tog] around (15)

RND 29: 15 sc (15)

RND 30: [3 sc, sc2tog] around (12)

RND 31: 12 sc (12)

RND 32: Sc2tog around (6)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] around (54)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 8 sc] around (60)

RND 11: 22 sc, [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] six times, 20 sc (66)

RNDS 12–19: 66 sc (66)

RND 20: 22 sc, [sc2tog, 2 sc] six times, 20 sc (60)

RND 21: 60 sc (60)

RND 22: [8 sc, sc2tog] around (54)

RND 23: 54 sc (54)

RND 24: [7 sc, sc2tog] around (48)

RNDS 25–26: 48 sc (48)

RND 27: [6 sc, sc2tog] around (42)

RNDS 28–29: 42 sc (42)

RND 30: [5 sc, sc2tog] around (36)

RND 31: [4 sc, sc2tog] around (30)

RND 32: [3 sc, sc2tog] around (24)

Fasten off, stuff firmly.

LEGS (2x)

With yarn A

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RNDS 8–11: 42 sc (42)

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Stuff piece.

FEET (2x)

With yarn D

RND 1: Ch 2, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

RND 2: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (6)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (8)

Change to yarn A

RNDS 4–11: 8 sc (8)

RND 12: Sc2tog around (4)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Stuff piece.

With yarn A

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 6 sc (6)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (9)

RND 4: 9 sc (9)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (12)

RND 6: 12 sc (12)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (15)

RND 8: 15 sc (15)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (18)

RND 10: 18 sc (18)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (21)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] around (54)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 8 sc] around (60)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 9 sc] around (66)

RND 12: 66 sc (66)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

BELLY PATCH BOTTOM

With yarn B

ROW 1: Ch 2, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn (3)

ROW 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 2 sc in each sc, turn (6)

ROW 3: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] across, turn (9)

ROW 4: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] across, turn (12)

ROW 5: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] across, turn (15)

ROW 6: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] across, turn (18)

ROW 7: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] across, turn (21)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew to bottom of belly patch across 15 sts.

ARMS (2x)

With yarn A

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (15)

RNDS 4–6: 15 sc, sl st in next st, ch 1, turn (15)

Stuff hand lightly.

RND 7: Pinch closed and work 7 sc through both thicknesses, ch 1, turn (7)

RND 8: Working in FLO for whole rnd, 7 sc, rotate to work on opposite side of sts, 6 sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in last st (15)

RNDS 9–20: 15 sc (15)

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

Stuff arm.

THUMBS (2x)

With yarn **D**

RND 1: Ch 2, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

Change to **A**

RND 2: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (6)

RND 3: 6 sc (6)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

BONE TOPS (2x)

With yarn **C**

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: 12 sc (12)

Fasten off first piece, do not fasten off the second. Continue to bone.

BONE

With yarn **C**

RND 1: 12 sc around 1st bone top, 12 sc around 2nd bone top (24)

RND 2: [2 sc, sc2tog] around (18)

RND 3: 18 sc (18)

RND 4: [1 sc, sc2tog] around (12)

RND 5: [4 sc, sc2tog] around (10)

RNDS 6–15: 10 sc (10)

Stuff piece, continue stuffing.

RND 16: [3 sc, sc2tog] around (8)

RND 17: [2 sc, sc2tog] around (6)

RND 18: [1 sc, sc2tog] around (4)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Close remaining 4 sts.

SKULL SIDES (4x)

With yarn **C**

ROW 1: Ch 5, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 3 sc, turn (4)

ROW 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 2 sc in next st, 3 sc, turn (5)

ROW 3: Ch 1, 5 sc, turn (5)

ROW 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, turn (6)

ROWS 5–7: Ch 1, 6 sc, turn (6)

ROW 8: Ch 1, 3 sc in next st, 5 sc, turn (8)

ROW 9: Ch 1, 7 sc, 3 sc in next st, turn (10)

ROW 10: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 9 sc, turn (11)

ROW 11: Ch 1, 4 sc, leave remaining sts unworked, turn (4)

ROW 12: Ch 1, sc2tog, 2 sc, turn (3)

ROWS 13–16: Ch 1, 3 sc, turn (3)

ROW 17: Ch 1, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (4)

ROW 18: Ch 1, 3 sc in next st, 3 sc, turn (6)

ROW 19: Ch 1, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (7)

ROWS 20–22: Ch 1, 7 sc, turn (7)

ROW 23: Ch 1, sc2tog, 5 sc, turn (6)

ROW 24: Ch 1, 4 sc, sc2tog, turn (5)

ROW 25: Ch 1, 5 sc, turn (5)

Fasten off.

Attach yarn **C** to last st of row 11.

ROW 12: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, leave remaining 2 sts unworked, turn (6)

ROW 13: Ch 1, sc2tog, 4 sc, turn (5)

ROWS 14–15: Ch 1, 5 sc, turn (5)

ROW 16: Ch 1, sc2tog, 3 sc, turn (4)

ROW 17: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, sc2tog, turn (4)

ROW 18: Ch 1, sc2tog, 1 sc, 3 sc in next st, turn (5)

ROW 19: Ch 6, 1 sc in 2nd ch, 1 sc in next 4 chs, 5 sc, turn (10)

ROW 20: Ch 1, sc2tog, 8 sc, turn (9)

ROW 21: Ch 1, 7 sc, sc2tog, turn (8)

ROW 22: Ch 1, sc2tog, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (8)

ROW 23: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 7 sc, turn (9)

ROW 24: Ch 1, 8 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (10)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew the small seam at the end of rows 19–24 closed. Continue on to joining round.

PROJECT 19/CUBONE

LEFT SIDE JOINING

Using yarn **C**. Hold two skull sides together and work through both thicknesses across the straight bottom edge toward the nose.

RND 1: 22 sc, 2 sc in corner, 3 sc across nose tip, 2 sc in corner, 7 sc across top of nose, 15 sc across top of skull, 10 sc down first part of back of skull, 7 sc down final edge, join. (68)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

RIGHT SIDE JOINING

Using yarn **C**. Hold two skull sides together and work through both thicknesses across the straight bottom edge toward the back of the skull.

RND 1: 22 sc, 7 sc up back edge, 10 sc up next part of back edge, 15 sc across top of skull, 7 sc across top of nose, 2 sc in corner, 3 sc across nose tip, 2 sc in corner, join (68)

SKULL TOP PIECES (2x)

With yarn **C**

ROW 1: Ch 11, sc in 2nd ch, 9 sc, turn (10)

ROWS 2–20: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 10 sc, turn (10)

ROW 21: Ch 1, 4 sc, sc2tog, 4 sc, turn (9)

ROWS 22–24: Ch 1, 9 sc, turn (9)

ROW 25: Ch 1, sc2tog, 7 sc, turn (8)

ROWS 26–28: Ch 1, 8 sc, turn (8)

ROW 29: Ch 1, 3 sc, sc2tog, 3 sc, turn (7)

ROWS 30–32: Ch 1, 7 sc, turn (7)

ROW 33: Ch 1, sc2tog, 5 sc, turn (6)

ROWS 34–36: Ch 1, 6 sc, turn (6)

ROW 37: Ch 1, sc2tog, 4 sc, turn (5)

ROWS 38–40: Ch 1, 5 sc, turn (5)

ROW 41: Ch 1, sc2tog, 3 sc, turn (4)

ROWS 42–44: Ch 1, 4 sc, turn (4)

ROW 45: Ch 1, sc2tog, 2 sc, turn (3)

ROW 46: Ch 1, 3 sc, turn (3)

Fasten off the first piece, do not fasten off the second piece. Place two pieces together and sc through both thicknesses for joining round.

JOINING RND 47: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc across tip, 2 sc in last st, rotate to work in row ends, 46 sc, 2 sc in first st of back of skull, 8 sc, 2 sc in last st of back of skull, rotate to work in row ends, 46 sc, 1 sc in same st as first st, join (109)

HORNS (2x)

With yarn **C**

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: In BLO, [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (9)

RND 3: 9 sc (9)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (12)

RNDS 5–7: 12 sc (12)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (15)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (18)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff piece.

FRONT TOOTH BONES (2x)

With yarn **C**

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: 12 sc (12)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

LAST TOOTH BONES (2x)

With yarn **C**

ROW 1: Ch 2, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn (3)

ROW 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (5)

ROW 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (7)

ROW 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (9)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

MIDDLE TOOTH BONES (2x)

With yarn **C**

RND 1: Ch 2, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

RND 2: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (6)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (9)

RND 4: 9 sc (9)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

LARGE SIDE BONE PIECES (4x)

With yarn **C**

Side Bone Piece Large (4X)

ROW 1: Ch 9, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc 7, turn (8)

ROWS 2–3: Ch 1, sc 9, turn (8)

ROW 4: Ch 1, sc 3 leaving remaining sts unworked, turn (3)

ROW 5: Ch 1, sc 3, do not turn (3).

Fasten off 1st piece, do not fasten off 2nd piece. Continue to joining round.

Joining **RND 5:** Working through both thicknesses rotate to work in row ends, sc 4 down side, 2 sc in corner, sc 7 across bottom edge (row 1 underside), 2 sc in last, sc 2 across row ends, 2 sc in corner, sc 5 across row 3, ch 2 to reach height of row 4, sl st (27)

ASSEMBLY

Refer to page 17 on sewing.

Sew skull sides to top of skull.

Place head insert inside skull.

Sew horns to top of skull leaving three rows above eye and overlapping skull seam.

Sew back skull bone to row 35 of skull.

Sew back skull tooth to bottom edge of skull across 8 sts.

Skip one stitch, sew middle skull tooth to next 6 sts.

Skip one stitch, sew last tooth to side front.

Sew belly patch between ends 5–26 of body, overlapping center bottom.

Sew tail above belly patch.

Sew small back spike above tail.

Sew large back spike above small back spike.

Sew leg haunch to round 10 of belly patch, and against edges of legs and tail.

Sew arms between ends 23–29 of body at an angle.

Sew feet to bottom of legs.

Sew head to top of body looking slightly downward.

Sew bone to right hand.

FACE

Following the templates cut two eyes out of white felt and glue them in the eye sockets.

Add black and white felt details to eyes.

Using black thread embroider skull details as shown with the dotted lines below.

Add black felt nostrils to front sides of skull.
