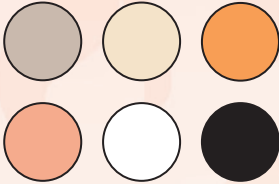

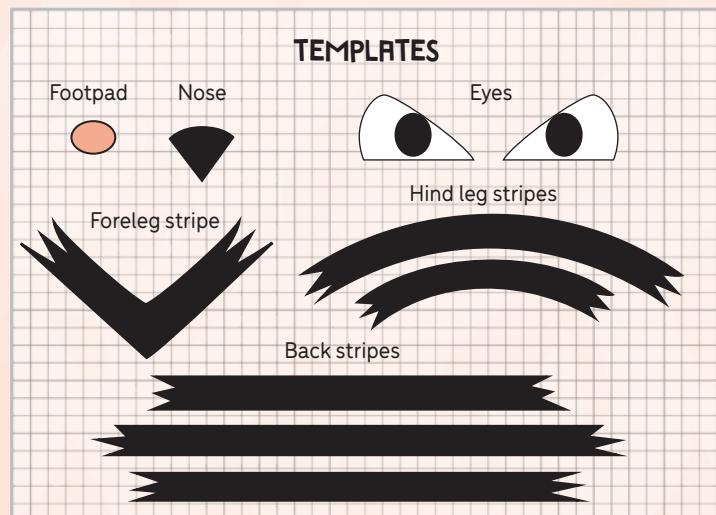

MATERIALS

- 22 grams, Golden Heather (A), #24005
10 grams, Bare (B), #23851
2 grams, Coriander Heather (C), #25544
(WeCrochet Palette Fingering)
- US No. 7 Steel crochet hook (1.5 mm)
- Metal brush
- Fiberfill
- Black, white and peach felt
- Black and white embroidery thread
- Black fabric pen

Finished size approximately
6 in (15 cm) tall



HEAD

With yarn A

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] around (54)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 8 sc] around (60)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 9 sc] around (66)

RNDS 12–27: 66 sc (66)

Stuff head.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HEAD



BODY

With yarn A

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] around (54)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 8 sc] around (60)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 9 sc] around (66)

RNDS 12–42: 66 sc (66)

RND 43: [9 sc, sc2tog] around (60)

RND 44: [8 sc, sc2tog] around (54)

RND 45: [7 sc, sc2tog] around (48)

RND 46: [6 sc, sc2tog] around (42)

RND 47: [5 sc, sc2tog] around (36)

RND 48: [4 sc, sc2tog] around (30)

RND 49: [3 sc, sc2tog] around (24)

Stuff body, continue stuffing as work progresses.

RND 50: [2 sc, sc2tog] around (18)

RND 51: [1 sc, sc2tog] around (12)

RND 52: Sc2tog around (6)

Fasten off, weave in ends.

MUZZLE

With yarn B

RND 1: Ch 14, sc in 2nd ch from hook, 11 sc, 3 sc in next st, rotate to work on the underside of starting ch, 12 sc, 3 sc in last st (30)

RND 2: 13 sc, 3 sc in next st, 14 sc, 3 sc in next st, 1 sc (34)

RND 3: 14 sc, 3 sc in next st, 16 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc (38)

RND 4: 15 sc, 3 sc in next st, 18 sc, 3 sc in next st, 3 sc (42)

RND 5: 16 sc, 3 sc in next st, 20 sc, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc (46)

RND 6: 17 sc, 3 sc in next st, 22 sc, 3 sc in next st, 5 sc (50)

RND 7: 18 sc, 3 sc in next st, 24 sc, 3 sc in next st, 6 sc (54)

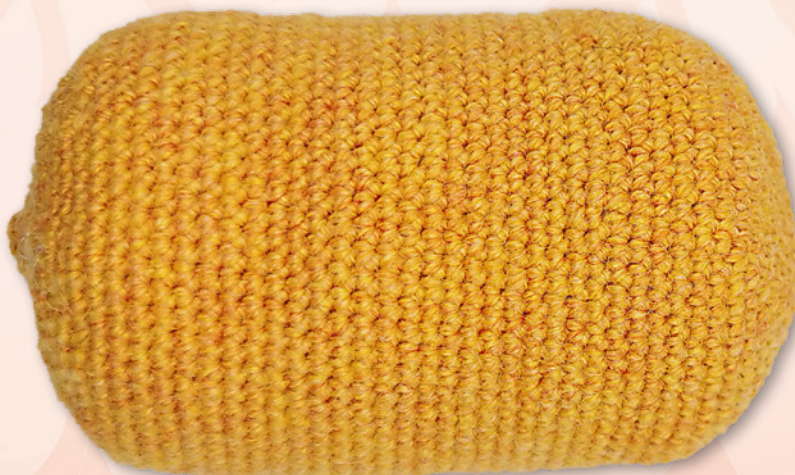
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff muzzle.

PROJECT 07/GROWLITHE

NOSE

With yarn B

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (14)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (16)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] around (18)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around, sl st, ch 1, turn (30)

Begin working in rows.

ROW 8: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] five times, leave remaining sts unworked, turn (30)

ROW 9: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] five times (35)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff nose.

HIND LEGS (2x)

With yarn A

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: 30 sc (30)

RND 7: 18 sc, [sc2tog] six times (24)

RND 8: 24 sc (24)

RND 9: [Sc2tog] twice, 12 sc, [sc2tog] four times (18)

RND 10: 18 sc (18)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RNDS 12–13: 24 sc (24)

RND 14: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RNDS 15–16: 30 sc (30)

RND 17: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RNDS 18–19: 36 sc (36)

Stuff legs, fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

FORELEGS (2x)

With yarn A

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: Working in BLO, 30 sc (30)

RNDS 7–19: 30 sc (30)

RND 20: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 21: 36 sc (36)

Stuff legs, fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

TAIL

With yarn B

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] around (54)

RNDS 10–18: 54 sc (54)

RND 19: [7 sc, sc2tog] around (48)

RND 20: [6 sc, sc2tog] around (42)

RND 21: [5 sc, sc2tog] around (36)

RND 22: [4 sc, sc2tog] around (30)

RND 23: [3 sc, sc2tog] around (24)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

TAIL FUR

Using yarn **B**, cut approximately fifty pieces of 4 inch-long strands and attach them to the tail. (1-4).

Using a metal brush, brush the piece to create fur.

Using a metal brush, brush the piece to create fur. (5).

Trim the fur around edges to shape.

Optional: Use a small amount of hair product to tame the edges and give shape.

TOES & CLAWS

To create toes, make two stitch lines with yarn **A** on the back feet and pull them tight.

To create claws, make stitch lines with white embroidery thread on the forelegs.



PROJECT 07/GROWLITHE

HEAD PIECE

With yarn **B**

ROW 1: Ch 2, 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn (2)

ROW 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 2 sc in each sc, turn (4)

ROW 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (6)

ROW 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (8)

ROW 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (10)

ROWS 6–15: 10 sc, turn (10)

ROW 16: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc across to last 2 sts, sc2tog, turn (8)

ROWS 17–19: Repeat ROW 16 (2 sc at end of ROW 19)

ROW 20: Ch 1, sc2tog (1)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

See instructions for tail fur. Using yarn **B**, cut approximately fifty pieces of 4 inch long strands and attach them to head piece.

Using a metal brush, brush the head piece to create fur.

BELLY PATCH

With yarn **B**

ROW 1: Ch 19, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn (18)

ROWS 2–32: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 18 sc, turn (18)

ROW 33: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc across to last 2 sts, sc2tog (16)

ROWS 34–39: Repeat ROW 33 (4 sc at the end of ROW 39)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

CHEST TUFT

With yarn **B**

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

See instructions for tail fur. Using **B**, cut approximately twenty pieces of 4 inch-long strands and attach them to the chest tuft.

Using a metal brush, brush the piece to create fur.

EARS (4x)

Make two with yarn **A** (outer ear), and two with yarn **C** (inner ear).

ROW 1: Ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn (4)

ROW 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 2 sc in next st, 3 sc, turn (5)

ROW 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, turn (6)

ROWS 4–7: Ch 1, 6 sc, turn (6)

ROW 8: Ch 1, sc2tog, 2 sc, sc2tog, turn (4)

ROW 9: Ch 1, [sc2tog] twice, turn (2)

ROW 10: Ch 1, sc2tog (1)

Fasten off, weave in ends.

JOINING RND 11: Using yarn **A** and holding a **C** piece on top of an **A** piece, sc through both thicknesses around entire piece, placing 3 sc in each corner. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

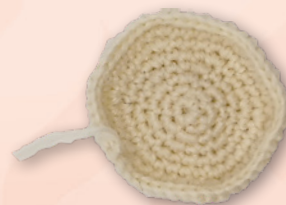
HEAD PIECE

ASSEMBLY

Refer to page 17 on sewing.

Sew head tuft to top of head between round 9 in the front, and round 15 in the back.

Sew muzzle to front of face between rounds 18 and final round.

Sew ears to sides of head between rounds 14–18.

Sew belly patch to bottom of body touching final round and spanning to round 10.

Sew chest tuft to front of body at round 7.

Sew front legs to body at rounds 8–19, overlapping belly patch.

Sew hind legs to body overlapping belly patch at rounds 4–18.

Sew tail to back of body.

Glue body and leg stripes using black felt.

Glue felt paw pads to each foot.



FACE

Cut eyes to shape with white felt using the template. Attach to the head just above muzzle with glue. Using a thin black fabric pen, and the template as a guide, add black details to the eyes including edging and pupil details.

Add black felt nose to tip of nose piece using black thread.

Embroider a mouth using black thread.
