

KNIT A BOX OF SOCKS ERRATA

Page no.	Errata
23	Underneath the colourwork charts it should say: Work in stockinette stitch until you've reached your desired leg length from your cast on edge. The sample was knit to 6in (15cm) from the cast on.
46	Round 2 in the Toe section should read: Magic Loop: Divide the stitches evenly between your two needles 32 (32, 40) stitches on the top needles, and 24, 32, 34 stitches on the bottom needles DPNS: Divide the stitches evenly between your four needles 14 (16) (18) sts on each needle. FOOT Switching to your MC, using either the written or charted instructions, complete the chart on the top needle until you've reached the required foot length. Place removable stitch marker or use waste yarn to mark location for the heel.
58	Heel Turn, Row 2 should read: Row 2 (WS): Sl1, p7, p2tog, p1, turn.
70	Heel Turn, Row 2 should read: Row 2 (WS): Sl1, p7, p2tog, p1, turn.
90	Heel: The first sentence of the second paragraph should read: Knit across the first 16 (18) (20) (22) (24) (26) sts separating the stitches into three equal parts using stitch markers.
91	Toe: The stitch counts in Magic Loop and DPNS were wrong in the first two print runs. They should be: Magic Loop: 8 (8, 10, 10, 10, 10) DPNS: 4 (4, 5, 5, 5, 5)
94	Heel: The first paragraph should read: Heel is worked flat with your CC on Section 2 or half the stitches 28 (32, 36).
95	Gusset: The first sentence should read: When decreasing gusset stitches, only work decreases on Section 2 or back of heel.
96	Charts: the key shows the 'ktbl' symbol wrongly labelled as 'k'

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116	Heel: The first sentence should read: Heel is worked flat with your CC on Needle 2
117	The final paragraph should read: <i>Continue knitting in pattern for the front of the sock until the work measures 2 (2) (2½) in / 5 (5) (6.5)cm shorter than the total foot length or desired negative ease.</i>
120	Long Tail Cast On instructions, final paragraph should read: 'Repeat steps 2-4... '
122	Kitchener Stitch: Steps 1 and 2 should read: 1. Put your darning needle through the first stitch on the front needle purl wise (A) and thread your yarn through leaving the stitch on the needle. 2. Then put your darning needle through the first stitch on the back needle knit wise (B) and thread your yarn through leaving the stitch on the needle.
