9	Abbreviations: 'wyib: with yarn in back' and 'wyif: with yarn in front' added
11	'Yarn': 2 nd paragraph changed to read: 'My squares weigh between 14g and 18g each, depending on the pattern. This means I get approximately three squares per 50g skein of yarn. Overall, I used approximately 20 balls of yarn (1kg) for the large blanket and approximately 10 balls (500g) for the baby blanket. If you choose needles of a different size and yarn of a different weight to those I suggest, these numbers will be different.'

29	'To make a yarn over' text should read: 'wrap the yarn around your RH needle (A)'
31	The SSK bullet point under Geeky Notes should read as follows: 'SSK (slip, slip, knit): as shown in this square sl 1 st knitwise, sl the next st knitwise, insert LH needle into the front of the 2 sl sts and knit them together '
38	Chart key symbol for k3 should read: RS: k3/WS: p3
41	Step image C corrected. You can download an amended page 41 from the 'Errata' page on the David and Charles website.
69	Instructions changed to:

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	'To sl a st purlwise wyib: insert the RH needle into the st from right to left and transfer the st to the RH needle... To sl a st purlwise wyif: insert the RH needle into the st from right to left, passing behind the working yarn as if to purl it. Transfer the st to the RH needle...'
74	Chart corrected. You can download an amended page 74 from the 'Errata' page on the David and Charles website.
77	Rnd 11 should read: 'Rnd 11: [SSK, k5, bring the long end of the CC yarn of this diamond over the LH needle to the front, leave a long loop hanging in the front of the work and place the yarn between the needles with the end to the back (D), k3, now take the loop with your left hand and place the yarn between your needles (E), k5, SSK , k2tog.'
79	The paragraph between rows 11 and 12 should read: 'This time I suggest you try knitting backwards as follows: kyok, k3 backwards, k3 forwards , CDD.'
83	Should read: 'On Row 12 you will make three knots and on Row 13 you will close the respective gaps. Row 12 (RS): Sl1p, k6, make knot, [k5, make knot] twice, k7.'
96	Triangle G: Row 3 should read: 'Sl1p, p3, p2tog , turn'
108	Row 7 should read: 'Row 7 (WS): Sl1p, k3, p19 , p20, k4.'
123	Reference for video clip added: 'See clip 51.1'

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123	Fourth paragraph changed to: 'You would think that if you have two sides with the same number of stitches, you can simply join them together one to one.'
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
