MATERIALS

- 10 grams, White (A), #26082 (WeCrochet Stroll Fingering)
- 10 grams, Cotton Candy (B), #24569
2 grams, Sky (C), #23724
1 gram, Pool (D) #23723 (WeCrochet Palette Fingering)
- US No. 7 Steel crochet hook (1.5 mm)
- Craft wire *
- Fiberfill
- Blue, light blue, and white felt
- Black embroidery thread

Finished size approximately
4.3 in tall x 5.5 in long
(11 cm x 14 cm)

Ears



HEAD

With yarn **A** and worked from top down

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 13 sc] around (45)

RNDS 9–14: 45 sc (45)

RND 15: 17 sc, 2 sc in next st, [2 sc, 2 sc in next st] three times, 18 sc (49)

RND 16: 18 sc, 2 sc in next st, [3 sc, 2 sc in next st] three times, 18 sc (53)

RNDS 17–19: 53 sc (53)

RND 20: 18 sc, sc2tog, [3 sc, sc2tog] three times, 18 sc (49)

RND 21: 17 sc, sc2tog, [2 sc, sc2tog] three times, 18 sc (45)

RND 22: [13 sc, sc2tog] around (42)

RND 23: [5 sc, sc2tog] around (36)

RND 24: [4 sc, sc2tog] around (30)

RND 25: [3 sc, sc2tog] around (24)

RND 26: [2 sc, sc2tog] around (18)

Stuff the head.

Fasten off with a sl st, leaving a tail for sewing.

BODY

With yarn **A**

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RNDS 7–24: 36 sc (36)

RND 25: [4 sc, sc2tog] around (30)

RND 26: [3 sc, sc2tog] around (24)

RND 27: [2 sc, sc2tog] around (18)

Stuff body and continue stuffing.

RND 28: [1 sc, sc2tog] around (12)

RND 29: Sc2tog around (6)

Fasten off with a sl st, leaving a tail for sewing.

FORELEGS (2x)

With yarn **B**

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: 2 sc in each of the next 4 sts, 8 sc (16)

RND 4: 16 sc (16)

RND 5: (Sc2tog) 4 times, 8 sc (12)

Begin colorwork

RND 6: 1 sc **B**, 2 sc **A**, 9 sc **B** (12)

RND 7: 4 sc **B**, 8 sc **A** (12)

RND 8: 5 sc **B**, 7 sc **A** (12)

RND 9: 6 sc **B**, 6 sc **A** (12)

With yarn **B**

RND 10: [2 sc in next, 3 sc] around (15)

RNDS 11–12: 15 sc (15)

Stuff the legs.

Fasten off with a sl st, leaving a tail for sewing.

HIND LEGS (2x)

With yarn **B**

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: 2 sc in each of the next 4 sts, 8 sc (16)

RND 4: (Sc2tog) 4 times, 2 sc, 2 sc in each of the next 4 sts, 2 sc (16)

RND 5: (Sc2tog) 3 times, 8 sc, sc2tog (12)

Begin colorwork

RND 6: 2 sc **A**, 10 sc **B** (12)

RND 7: 4 sc **A**, 8 sc **B** (12)

RND 8: 5 sc **A**, 7 sc **B** (12)

RND 9: 6 sc **A**, 6 sc **B** (12)

With yarn **A**

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RNDS 11–12: 18 sc (18)

Stuff the legs.

Fasten off with a sl st, leaving a tail for sewing.

EARS (2x)

With yarn **B**, leave a long starting tail for sewing.

RND 1: Ch 12, join with a sl st to form a ring (12)

RNDS 2–3: 12 sc (12)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (15)

RNDS 5–6: 15 sc (15)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (18)

RNDS 8–13: 18 sc (18)

RND 14: 12 sc, leaving remaining 6 sts unworked (12)

RNDS 15–18: 12 sc (12)

RND 19: Sc2tog around (6)

Fasten off, sew these six stitches closed. Weave in end.

RND 20: Fasten yarn **B** to any of the remaining sts from round 14, ch 1, 6 sc around (6)

RND 21: 6 sc (6)

Fasten off, sew remaining six stitches closed. Weave in end.

HEAD PIECE

With yarn **B**

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

RNDS 9–13: 48 sc (48)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

With yarn **B**

ROW 1: Ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn (1)

ROW 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 3 sc in next st, turn (3)

ROW 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (5)

ROW 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (7)

ROW 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (9)

ROW 6: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 7 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (11)

ROW 7: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 9 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (13)

ROW 8: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 11 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (15)

ROW 9: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 13 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (17)

ROW 10: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, 15 sc, 2 sc in next st, turn (19)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew forehead piece to edge of head piece.

HEAD TUFT SMALL PIECE

With yarn **B**

RND 1: Ch 2, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

RNDS 2-4: 4 sc (4)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HEAD TUFT LARGE PIECE

With yarn **B**

RND 1: Ch 2, 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook (5)

RNDS 2-4: 5 sc (5)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

BOWS (4x)

With yarn **B**, leave a long starting tail for sewing.

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 6 sc (6)

RND 3: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 4: 12 sc (12)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

Change to yarn **A**

RND 6: 9 sc, 9 hdc (18)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] three times, [2 hdc in next st, 2 hdc] three times (24)

RNDS 8-9: 12 sc, 12 hdc (24)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Fold in half. Pinch final row and sew remaining sts shut through both thicknesses, stuffing as you go.

Weave in ends.

Sew two pieces together at round 1 for each bow.

PROJECT 12/SYLVEON

RIBBONS (4x)

With yarn A

ROW 1: Ch 4, sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc, turn (3)

ROWS 2–69: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 3 sc, turn (3)

Fasten off 1st and 3rd piece, do not fasten off 2nd and 4th piece.

JOINING RND 70: Ch 1, rotate to work 68 sc evenly across row ends of two pieces through both thicknesses. Fasten off, repeat on opposite edge. (68)

Add craft wire to ribbon length.

Weave in ends.

RIBBON TIPS (8x)

With yarn C

RND 1: Ch 2, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

RND 2: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (6)

RND 3: 6 sc (6)

Fasten off.

Set aside to add two pieces together in joining round.

JOINING RND 4: Holding two pieces together 3 sc, 6 sc on next piece, 3 sc in remaining sts of the first piece (12)

RNDS 5–6: 12 sc (12)

RND 7: [1 dc, 1 hdc, 2 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc] around (12)

Change to yarn D

RNDS 8–9: 12 sc (12)

Change to yarn B

RNDS 10–11: 12 sc (12)

Change to yarn A

RND 12: 12 sc (12)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew ribbon tips to each end of ribbon.

Weave in ends.

TAIL PIECE

With yarn B

RND 1: Ch 2, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

RND 2: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (6)

RND 3: 6 sc (6)

Fasten off, set aside to add to tail in joining round.

TAIL

With yarn B

RND 1: Ch 2, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

RND 2: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (6)

RND 3: 6 sc (6)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (9)

RND 5: 9 sc (9)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (12)

RNDS 7–9: 12 sc (12)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (15)

RNDS 11–12: 15 sc (15)

JOINING RND 13: Incorporate tail piece by working 6 sc around tail piece, then 15 sc around tail (21)

RNDS 14–15: 21 sc (21)

RND 16: [5 sc, sc2tog] around (18)

RNDS 17–18: 18 sc (18)

RND 19: [4 sc, sc2tog] around (15)

RNDS 20–21: 15 sc (15)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff tail lightly.



ASSEMBLY

Refer to page 17 on sewing.

Sew the head to the body at rounds 6–12.

Sew head piece to round 15 of face, and round 19 to back of head.

Sew ears to round 9 of head piece.

Glue blue felt pieces to center of each ear.

Sew tufts on the right side of the head piece with the smaller piece under the larger.

Sew the legs to the body. Sew the forelegs at round 6–10, and the hind legs at round 18–23.

Sew tail to round 24 of body over 4 sts.

Sew center of first ribbon to front of left ear. Wrap around back of right ear and rest in front of right ear. Let other end trail behind head.

Sew bow to front of ribbon in front of left ear.

Sew second ribbon to center of chest under chin.

Let length of each side of ribbon trail along body.

Sew second bow to center of second ribbon.

Glue blue felt to center of each ear.

FACE

Cut two eyes each out of light blue felt and white felt. Glue them to head at rounds 11–14 with 5 sts between them. Add white felt circle to each eye.

Embroider the nose at round 15 with black thread, refer to the template for the shape.

Embroider a mouth at round 18.
