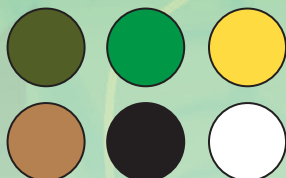

While in the sun, photosynthesis takes place across the body of this Pokémon, creating oxygen. The shell on its back is actually hardened soil, and the leaf on its head wilts if it is thirsty.

MATERIALS

- 20 grams, Green Tea Heather (A), #24258
- 5 grams, Doe (B), #24240
- 5 grams, Canary (C), #25531
- 1 gram, Black (D), #23729
(WeCrochet Palette Fingering)
- US No. 7 Steel crochet hook (1.5 mm)
- Fiberfill
- Black, white, green and yellow felt
- Black embroidery thread

Finished size approximately
4 in high x 5.9 in long
(10 cm x 15 cm)

Special Instruction
BLO = back loop only



BODY PIECES (2x)

With yarn A.

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] around (54)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 8 sc] around (60)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 9 sc] around (66)

RND 12: [2 sc in next st, 10 sc] around (72)

RND 13: [2 sc in next st, 11 sc] around (78)

RND 14: [2 sc in next st, 12 sc] around (84)

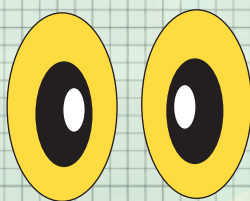
RND 15: [2 sc in next st, 13 sc] around (90)

RNDS 16–19: 90 sc (90)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.
Sew two pieces together, stuffing piece as
sewing progresses.

HEAD

With yarn **B**

RND 1: Ch 2, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

RND 2: 4 sc (4)

RND 3: 2 sc in next st, 3 sc (5)

RND 4: 5 sc (5)

RND 5: 2 sc in next st, 4 sc (6)

RND 6: 6 sc (6)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (9)

RND 8: 9 sc (9)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (12)

RND 10: 12 sc (12)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (15)

RND 12: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (20)

RND 13: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (25)

RND 14: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (30)

Begin colorwork section.

RND 15: [2 sc in next st **B**, 1 sc **B**, 1 sc **A**, 3 sc **B**] around (35)

RND 16: [2 sc **B**, skip next st, 2 sc in next st **A**, 2 sc in next st **A**, 2 sc **B**] around (40)

RND 17: [1 sc **B**, skip next st, 2 sc in next st **A**, 2 sc **A**, 2 sc in next st **A**, 2 sc **B**] around (45)

RND 18: Skip next st, 2 sc in next st **A**, 4 sc **A**, 2 sc in next st **A**, 2 sc **B**] around (50)

RND 19: [2 sc in next st **A**, 6 sc **A**, 2 sc in next st **A**, 1 sc **B**, skip next st] around (55)

Using yarn **A** only

RND 20: [2 sc in next st, 10 sc] around (60)

RND 21: [2 sc in next st, 9 sc] around (66)

RND 22: 24 sc, [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] six times (72)

RND 23: 24 sc, [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] six times (78)

RND 24: 24 sc, [2 sc in next st, 8 sc] six times (84)

RND 25: 24 sc, [2 sc in next st, 9 sc] six times (90)

Begin short rows.

SHORT ROW 26: 80 sc, leave remaining 10 sts unworked, turn (80)

SHORT ROW 27: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), 11 sc, [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] six times, 11 sc, turn (52)

SHORT ROW 28: Ch 1, 52 sc, sc in unworked 10 sts from row 26, do not turn (62)

RND 29: 34 sc to start of short rows, 62 sc across top of short rows (96)

RNDS 30–36: 96 sc (96)

RND 37: Skip 24 sts, ch 18 (neck opening made), 72 sc (72)

RND 38: 1 sc in each ch, 24 sc, 24 sc in BLO (beak base made), 24 sc (90)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

CHIN

With yarn **C**

ROW 1: Ch 2, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn (3)

ROW 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 2 sc in each sc, turn (6)

ROW 3: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] across, turn (9)

ROW 4: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] across, turn (12)

ROW 5: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] across, turn (15)

ROW 6: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] across, turn (18)

ROW 7: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] across, turn (21)

ROW 8: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] across, turn (24)

ROW 9: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] across, turn (27)

ROW 10: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 8 sc] across, turn (30)

Rotate and work across bottom edge row-ends.

ROW 11: Ch 1, 20 sc across, turn (20)

ROW 12–22: Ch 1, 20 sc, turn (20)

Change to yarn **A**

ROWS 23–26: Ch 1, 20 sc, turn (20)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew chin to bottom of head with row 26 in line with neck line.

Stuff head firmly.

BODY

PROJECT 15/TURTLEWIG

BEAK

With yarn A

ROW 1: Working in 24 FLO remaining from rnd 38 of head, sl st in 1st st, sc2tog over next 2 sts, 18 sc, sc2tog, sl st in last st, turn (22)

ROW 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), skip next st, sl st in next st, sc2tog, 14 sc, sc2tog, sl st in next st, skip last st, turn (18)

ROW 3: Ch 1, skip next st, sl st in next st, sc2tog, 10 sc, sc2tog, sl st in next st, skip last st, turn (14)

ROW 4: Ch 1, skip next st, sl st in next st, sc2tog, 6 sc, sc2tog, sl st in next st, skip last st, turn (10)

ROW 5: Ch 1, skip next st, sl st in next st, sc2tog, 2 sc, sc2tog, sl st in next st, skip last st, turn (6)

ROW 6: Ch 1, skip next st, sc2tog twice, skip next st, turn (2)

ROW 7: Ch 1, sc2tog (1)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.
Sew side edges to head, weave in ends.

CHEEKS (2x)

With yarn C

ROW 1: Ch 2, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, turn (3)

ROW 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), 2 sc in each sc, turn (6)

ROW 3: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] across, turn (9)

ROW 4: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] across, turn (12)

ROW 5: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] across, turn (15)

ROW 6: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] across, turn (18)

ROW 7: Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] across, do not turn (21)

Rotate and work across bottom edge row-ends.

ROW 8: Ch 1, 18 sc across bottom edge row ends, do not turn (18)

Begin working in rounds.

RND 9: 39 sc (39)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 12 sc] around (42)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 13 sc] around (45)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

SHELL

With yarn B

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] around (30)

RND 6: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

RND 7: [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] around (42)

RND 8: [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] around (48)

RND 9: [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] around (54)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 8 sc] around (60)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 9 sc] around (66)

RND 12: [2 sc in next st, 10 sc] around (72)

RND 13: [2 sc in next st, 11 sc] around (78)

Change to yarn D

RND 14: [2 sc in next st, 12 sc] around (84)

RND 15: [2 sc in next st, 13 sc] around (90)

RNDS 16–19: 90 sc (90)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

SHELL STRIPE

With yarn D

ROW 1: Ch 24, sc in 2nd ch from hook, 22 sc, turn (23)

ROWS 2–4: Ch 1, 23 sc, turn (23)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

HIND LEGS (2x)

With yarn C

RND 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc (12)

RND 3: [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] around (18)

RND 4: [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] around (24)

RND 5: Working in BLO 2 sc in next st, 23 sc (25)

Begin colorwork section.

RND 6: [2 sc C, 1 sc A, 2 sc C] around (25)

RND 7: [1 sc C, 3 sc A, 1 sc C] around (25)

RND 8: [1 sc C, 4 sc A] around (25)

Using yarn A only

RND 9: 25 sc (25)

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (30)

RNDS 11–12: 30 sc (30)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.
Stuff leg.

CHEEK

SHELL STRIPE



FORELEGS (2x)

With yarn C.

RNDS 1–5: Repeat Rnds 1–5 of hind leg.

RND 6: 25 sc (25)

RNDS 7–9: Repeat rnds 6–8 of hind leg.

RND 10: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (30)

RND 11: [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] around (36)

Using yarn A only, begin short rows.

SHORT ROW 12: 15 sc, turn (15)

SHORT ROW 13: Ch 1, 15 sc, turn (15)

RND 14: Ch 1, 15 sc, sc in remaining 21 sts (36)

RND 15: 36 sc (36)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff leg.

TAIL

With yarn A

RND 1: Ch 2, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4)

RND 2: 2 sc in next st, 3 sc (5)

RND 3: 2 sc in next st, 4 sc (6)

RND 4: 2 sc in next st, 5 sc (7)

RND 5: 2 sc in next st, 6 sc (8)

RND 6: 2 sc in next st, 7 sc (9)

RND 7: 2 sc in next st, 8 sc (10)

RND 8: 2 sc in next st, 9 sc (11)

RND 9: 2 sc in next st, 10 sc (12)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff tail.

ASSEMBLY

Refer to page 17 on sewing.

Sew shell to top of body.

Sew cheeks to sides of face in line with chin seam, stuffing as sewing progresses.

Sew head to body overlapping edge of shell with outline of neck.

Sew shell stripe to middle of shell.

Sew legs to bottom of body.

Sew tail to back of body under shell edge.

Sew green felt leaves to either side of top of head.

FACE

Cut two eyes out of the yellow, black and white felt following the template. Glue the yellow felt to Turtwig's face at start of short rows. Add the black and white felt details to each eye.

Add black and white details to eyes.

Embroider nostrils between eyes using black thread.
